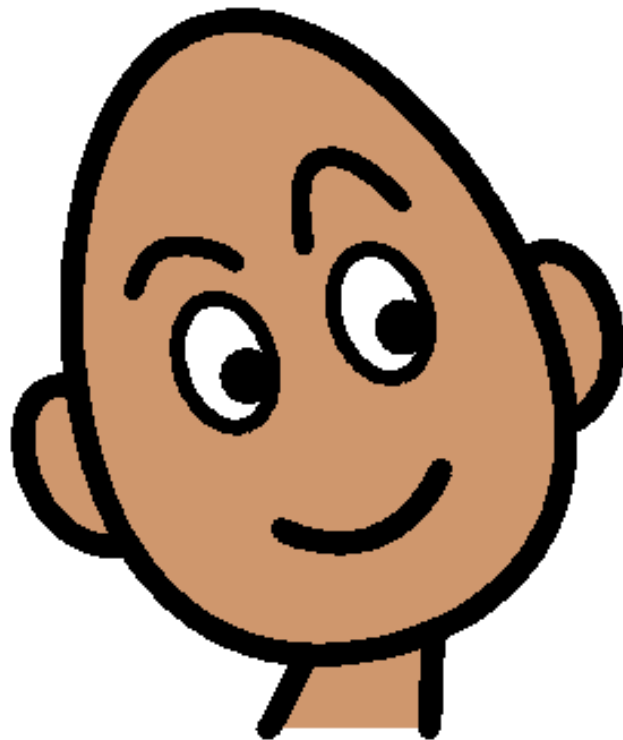
My school has a special plan to help keep everyone safe during the Corona virus.



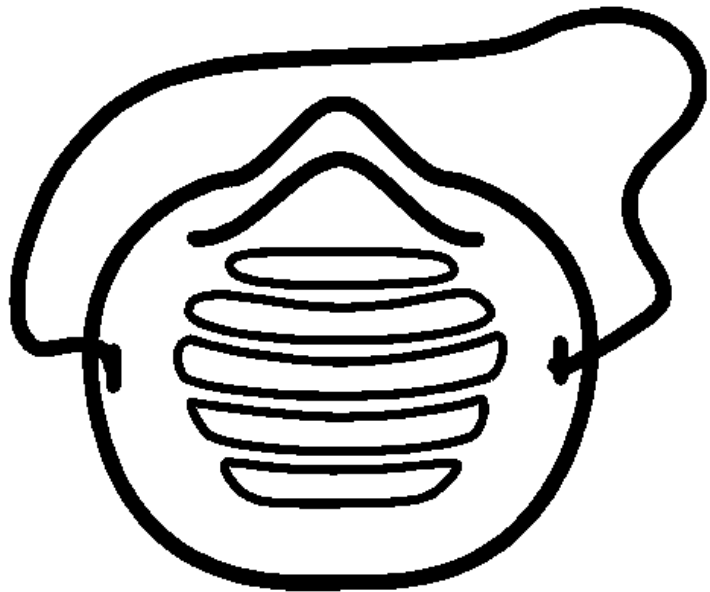
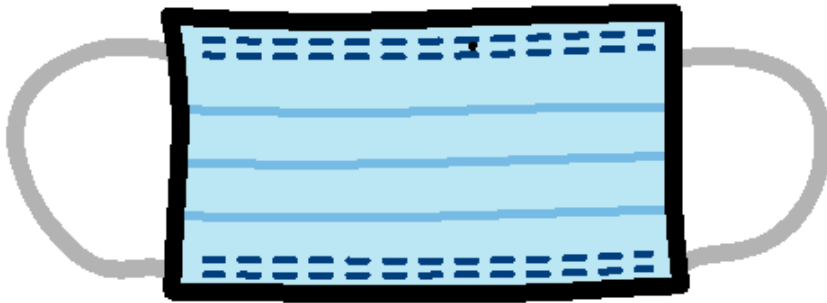
The custodians work hard to keep my school clean.



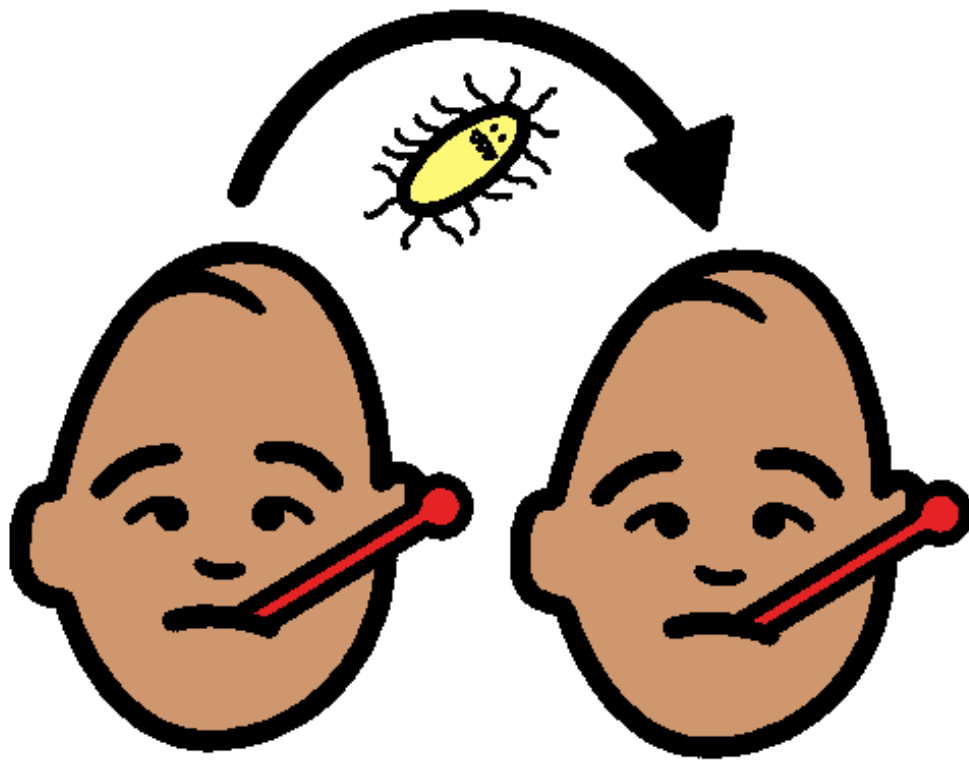
