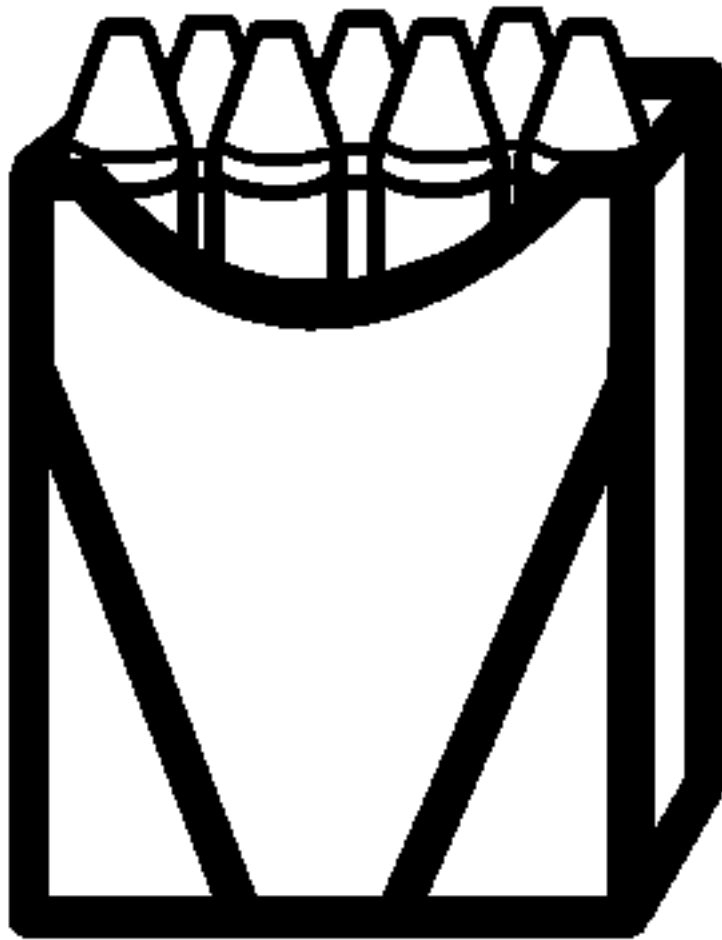
Jacob was a new student in our class.



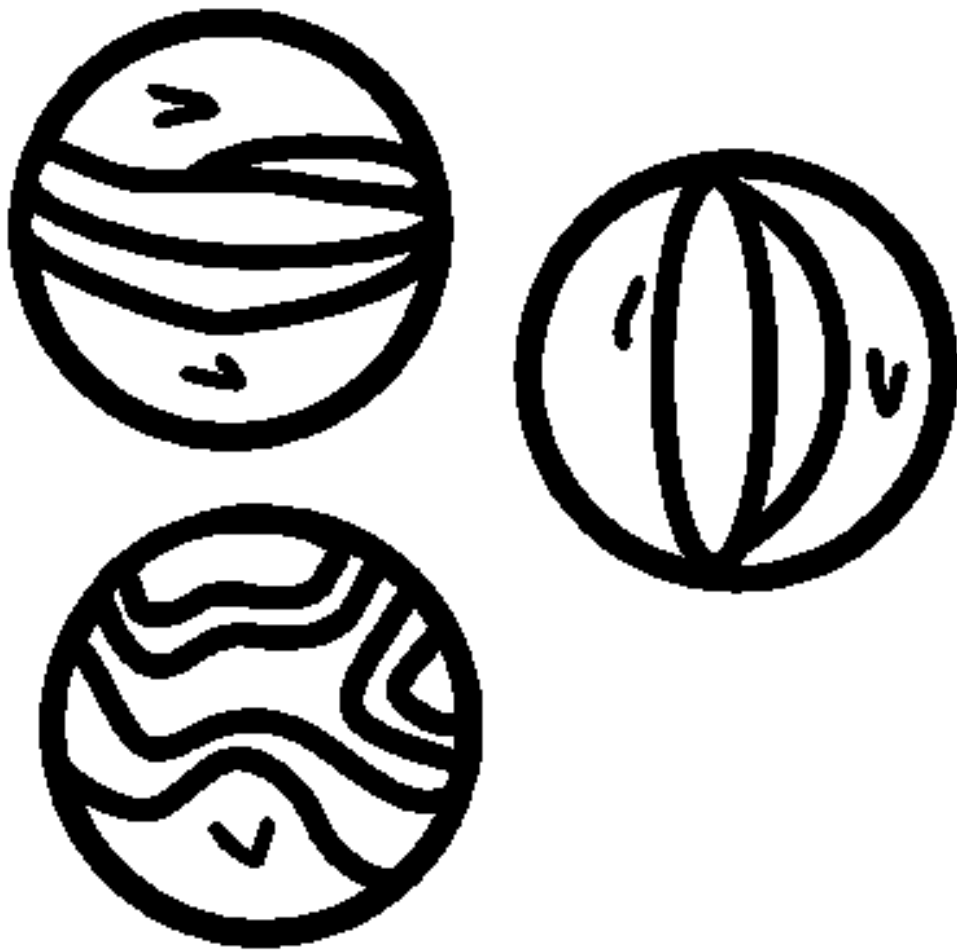
Jacob's favourite
colour was pink.



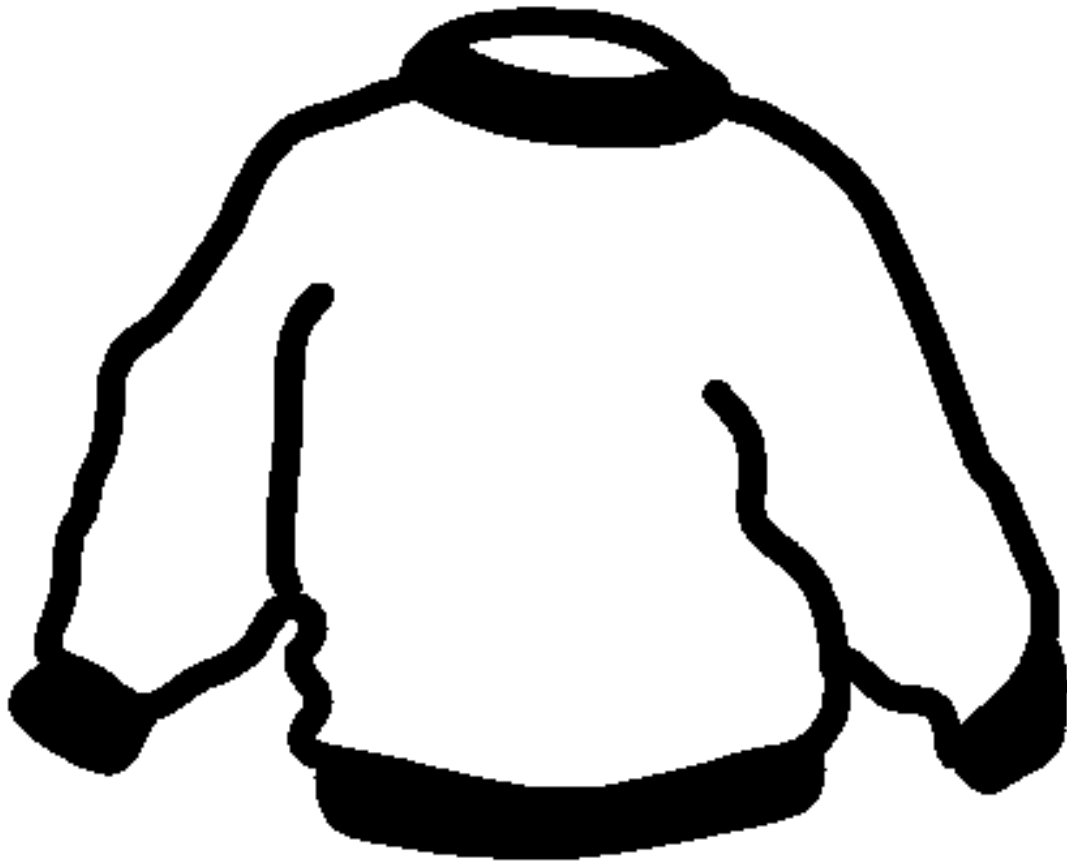
Jacob liked to draw

pink things.



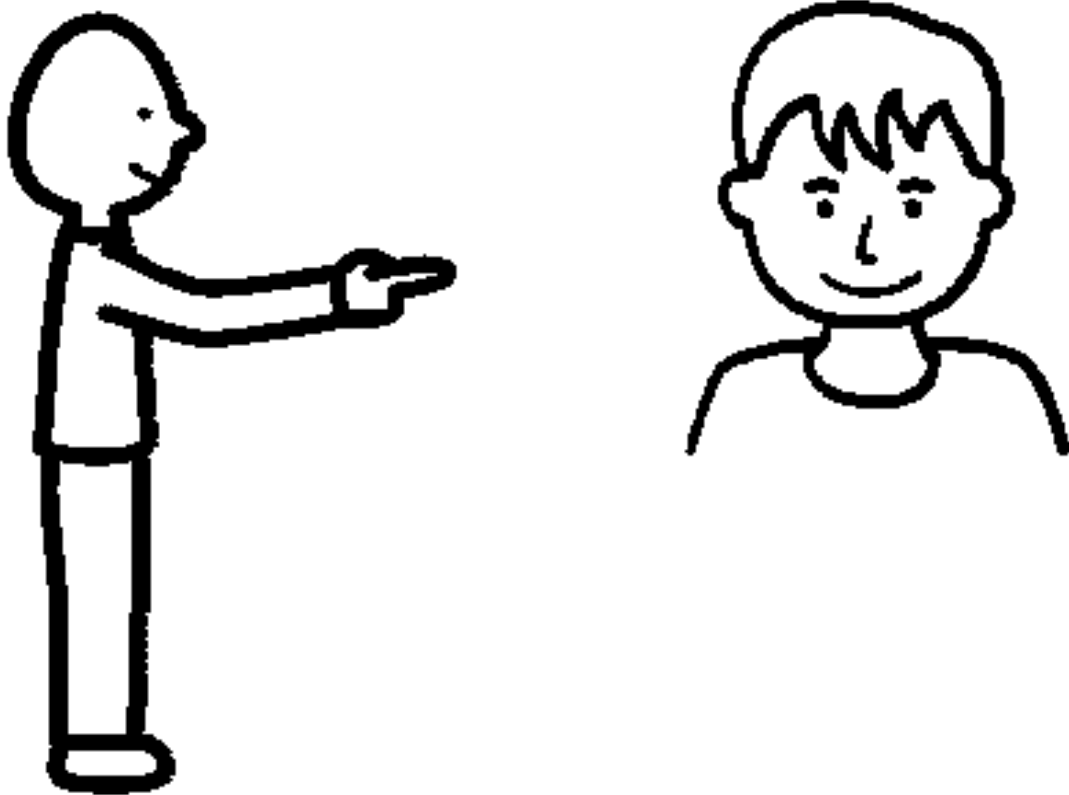
Jacob liked
pink marbles.



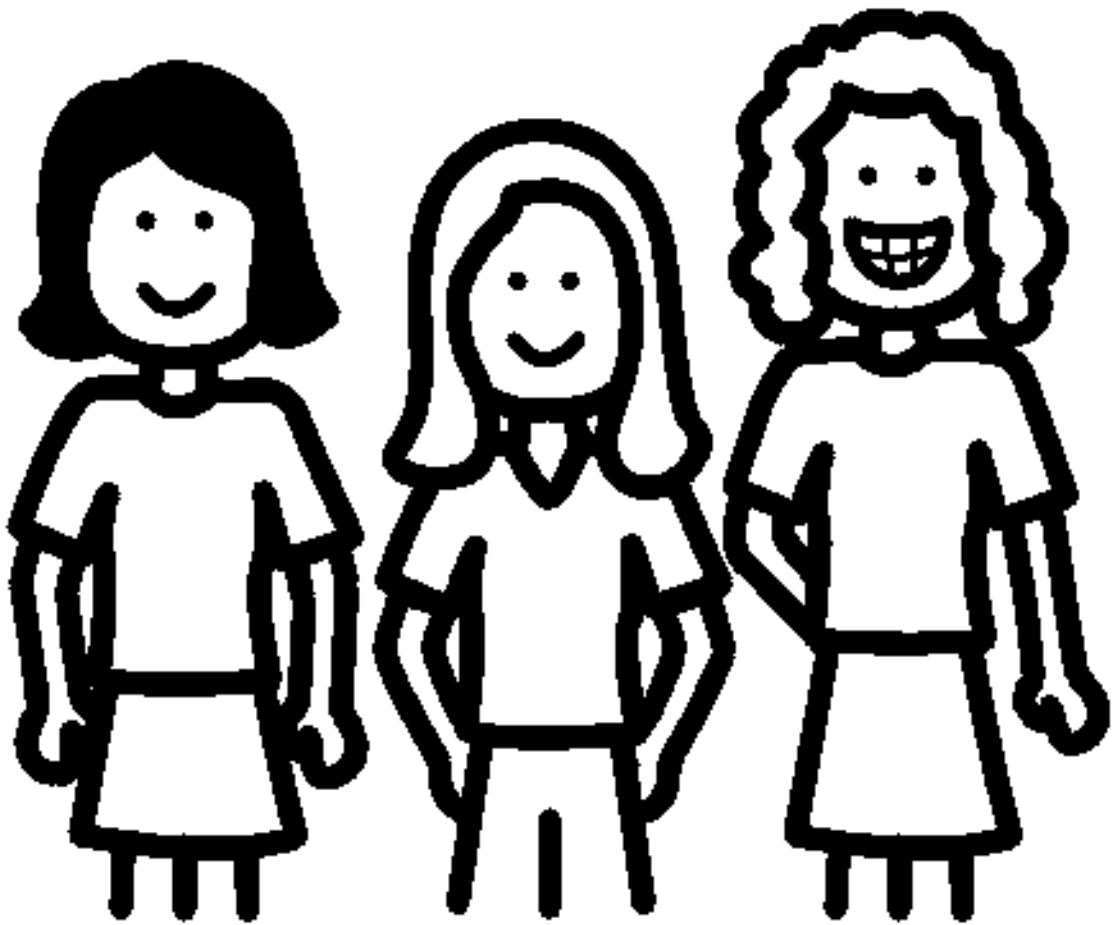
Jacob liked to wear

to cry.



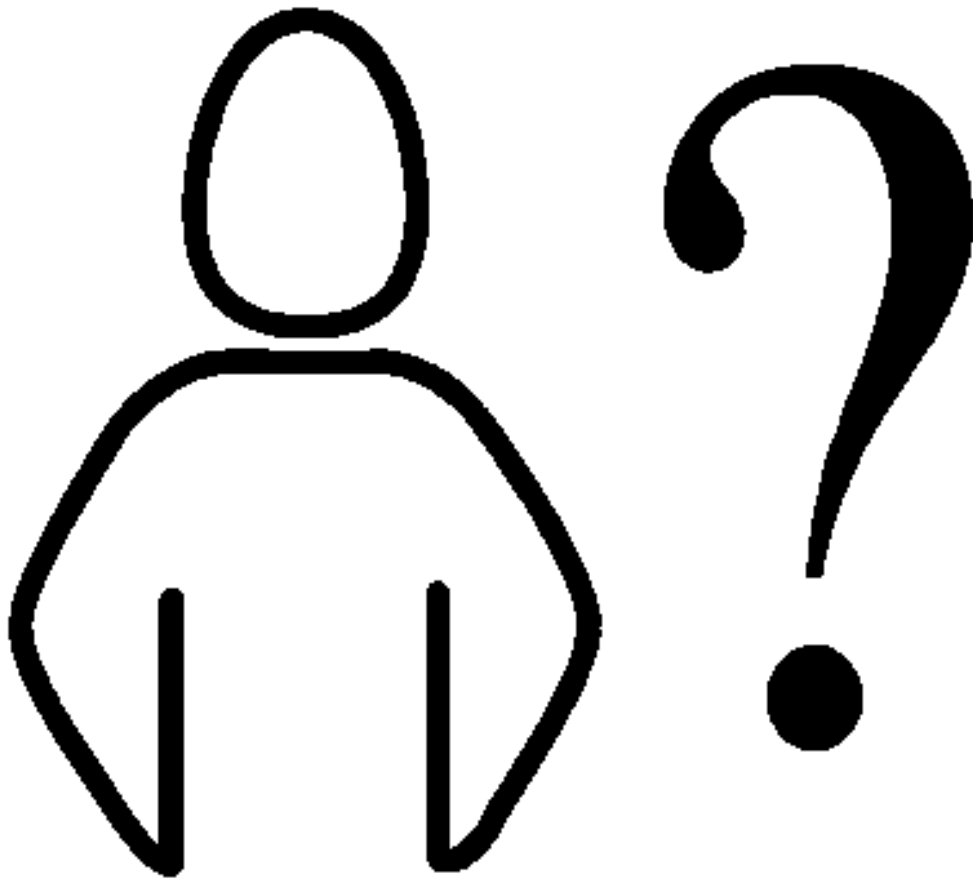
He was afraid to wear pink because he didn't want to get teased or laughed at.



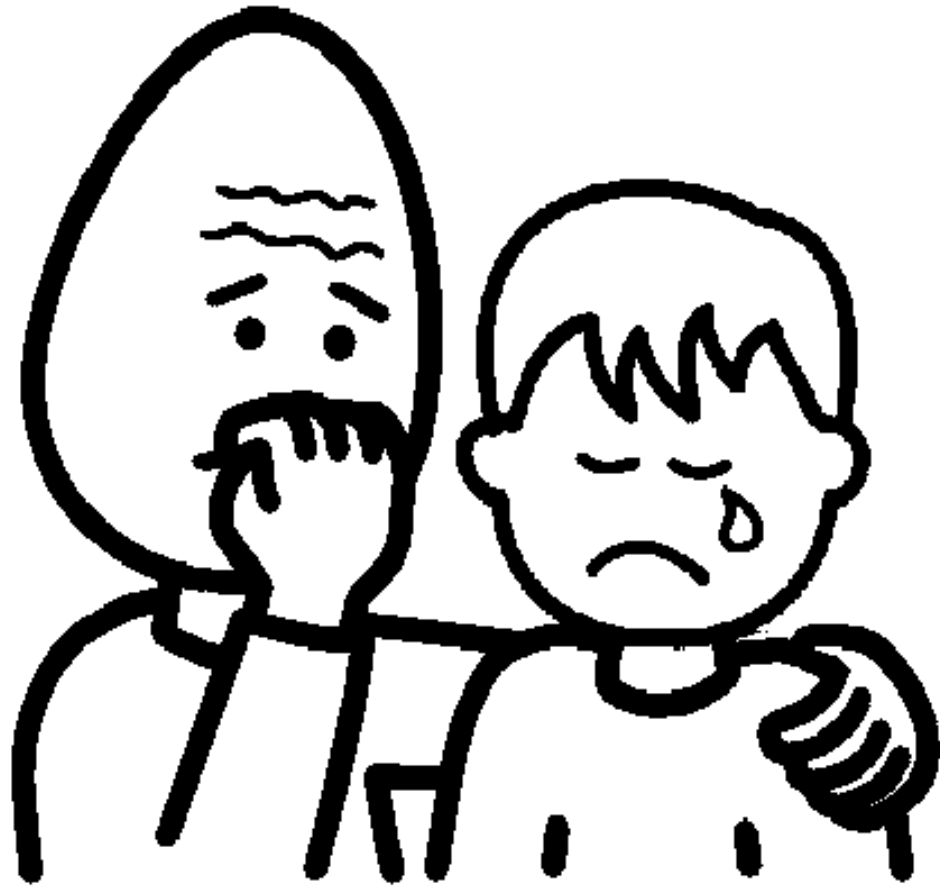
The next day,

about Jacob.



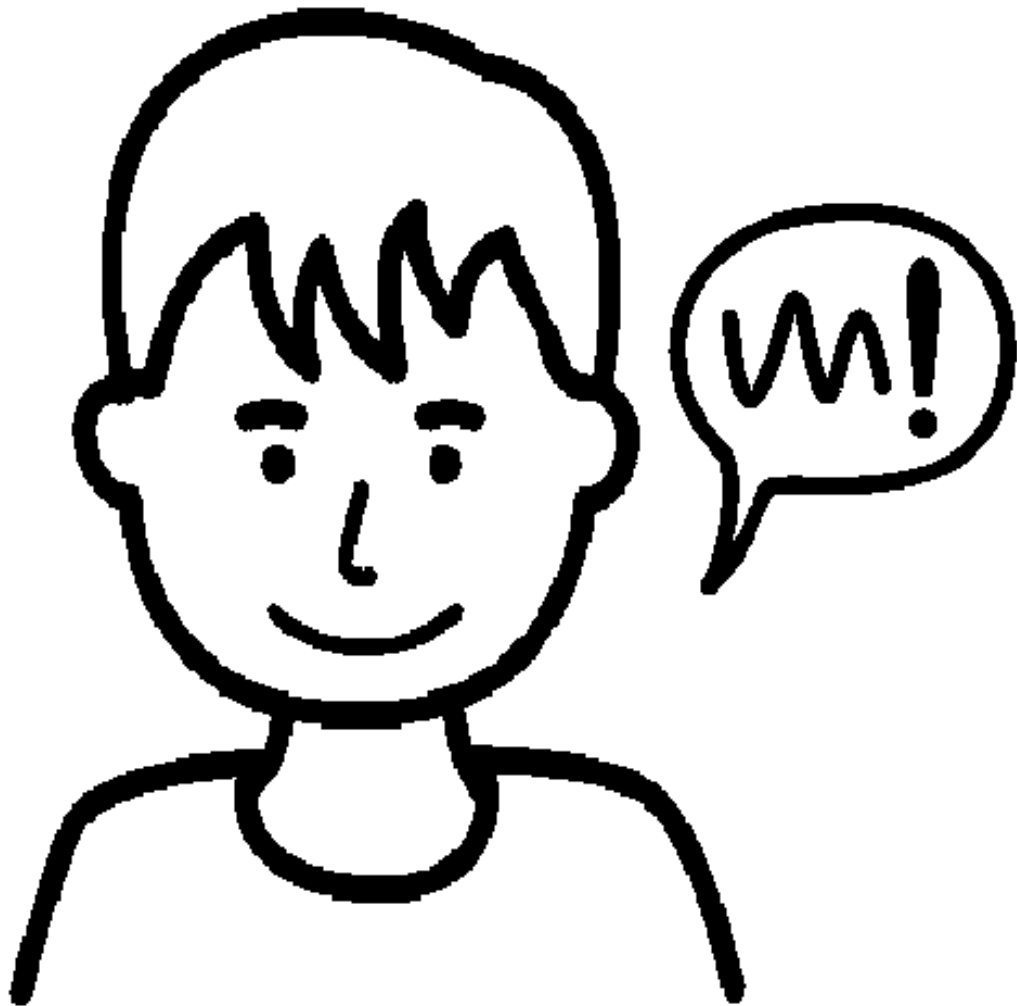
Tim liked Jacob just

The next day at school, Tim arrived wearing a pink shirt.



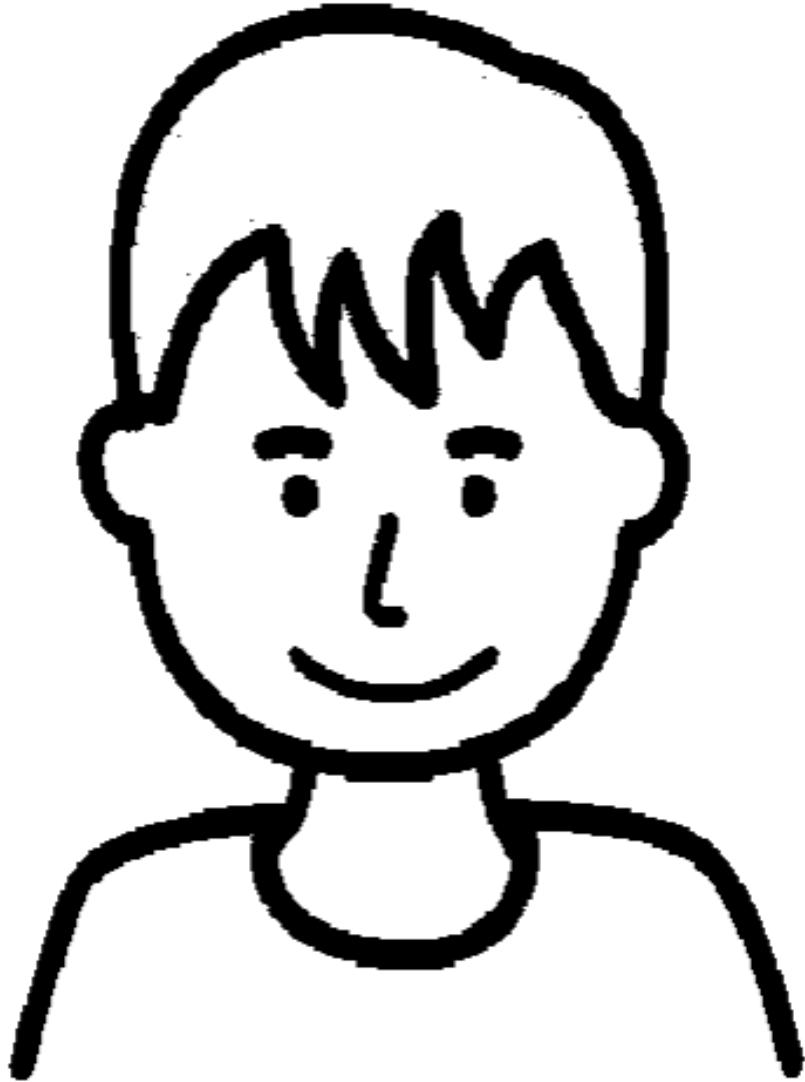
“You’re wearing pink!” Jacob said.

strawberry yogurt!”



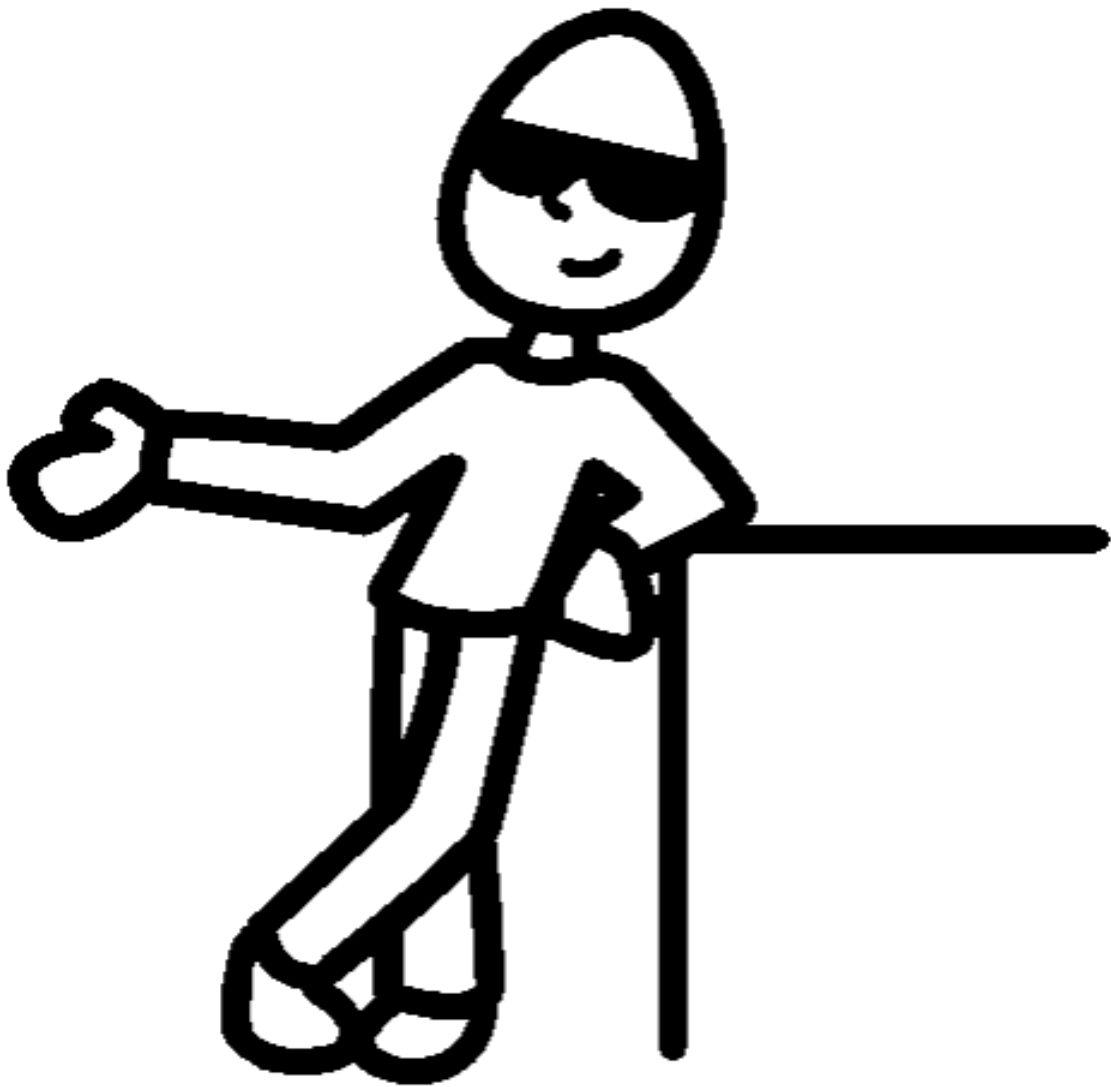
Jacob smiled.



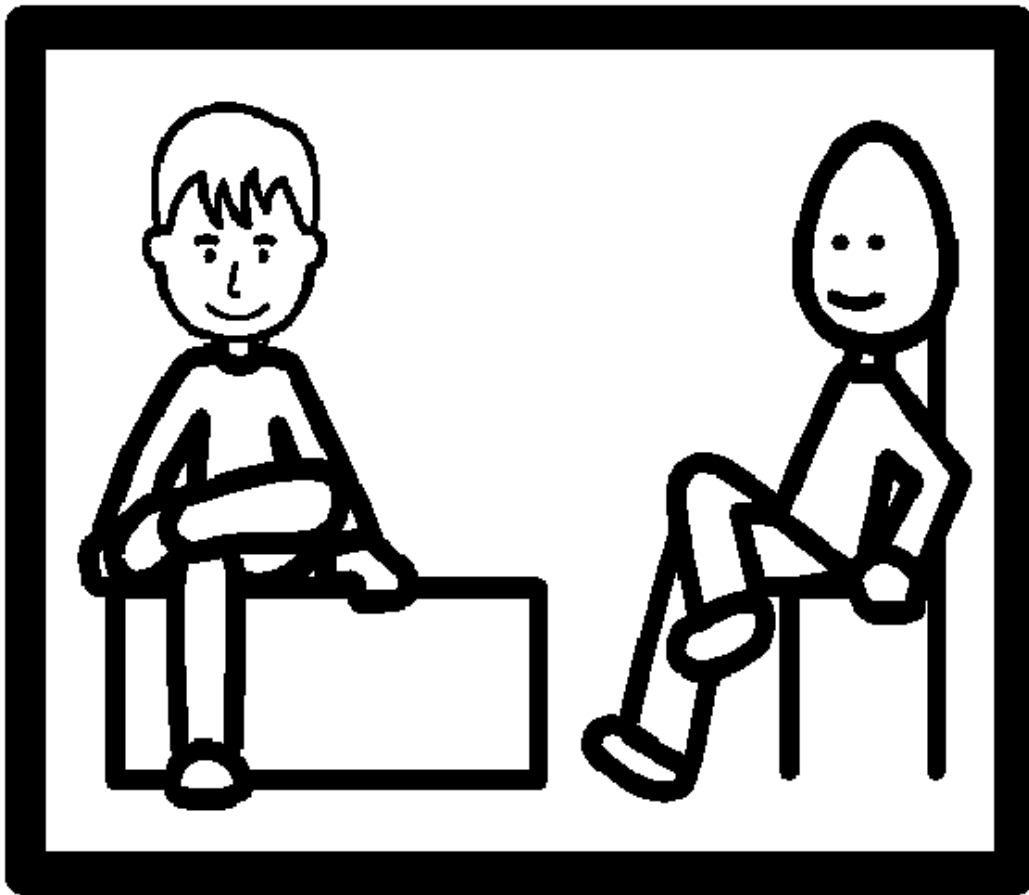
Tim was a popular

pink shirt.



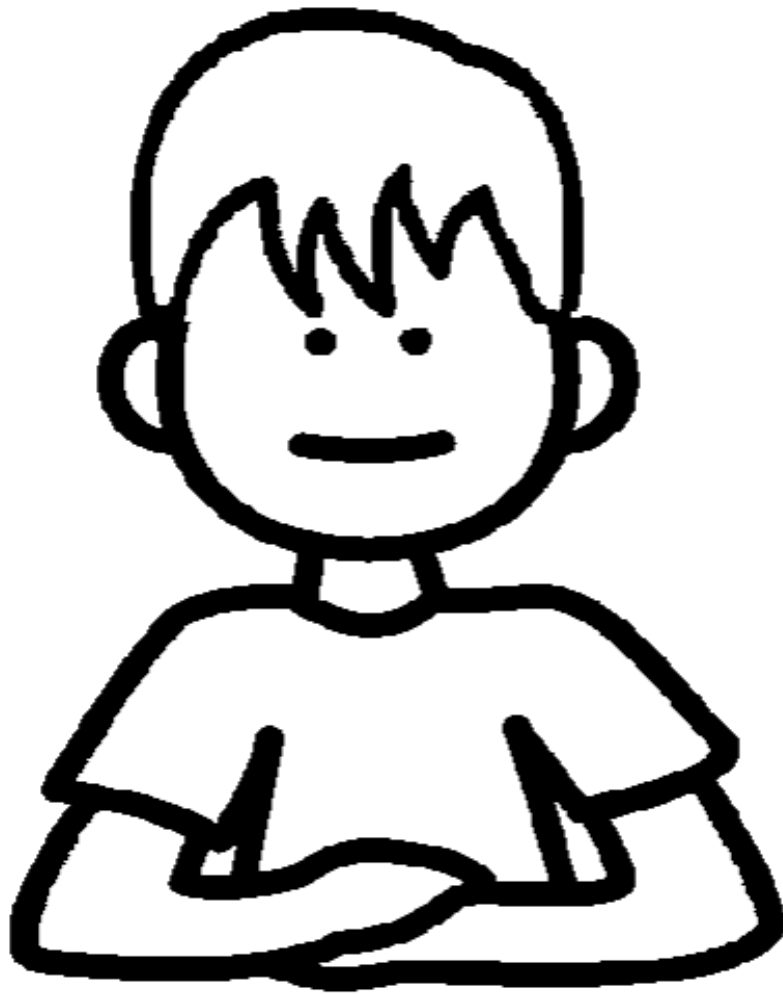
Tim told everyone,
“pink is cool.”



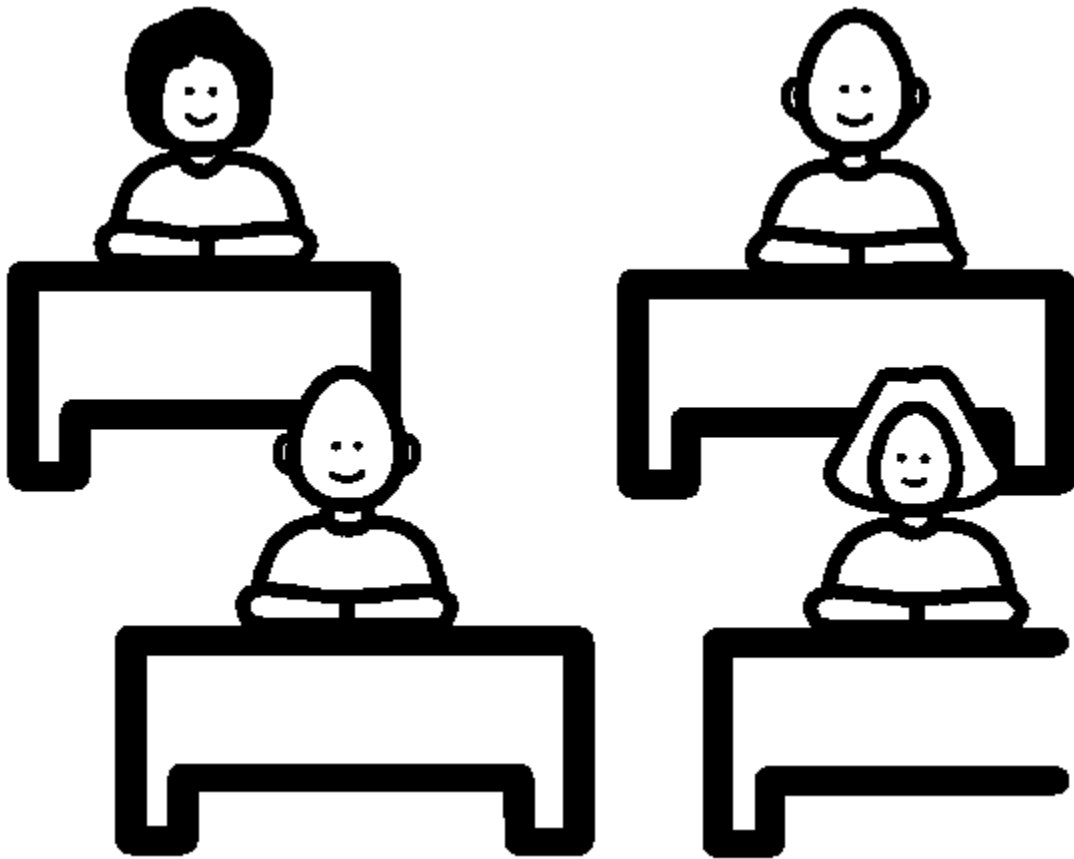
The next day,

wore pink to school.



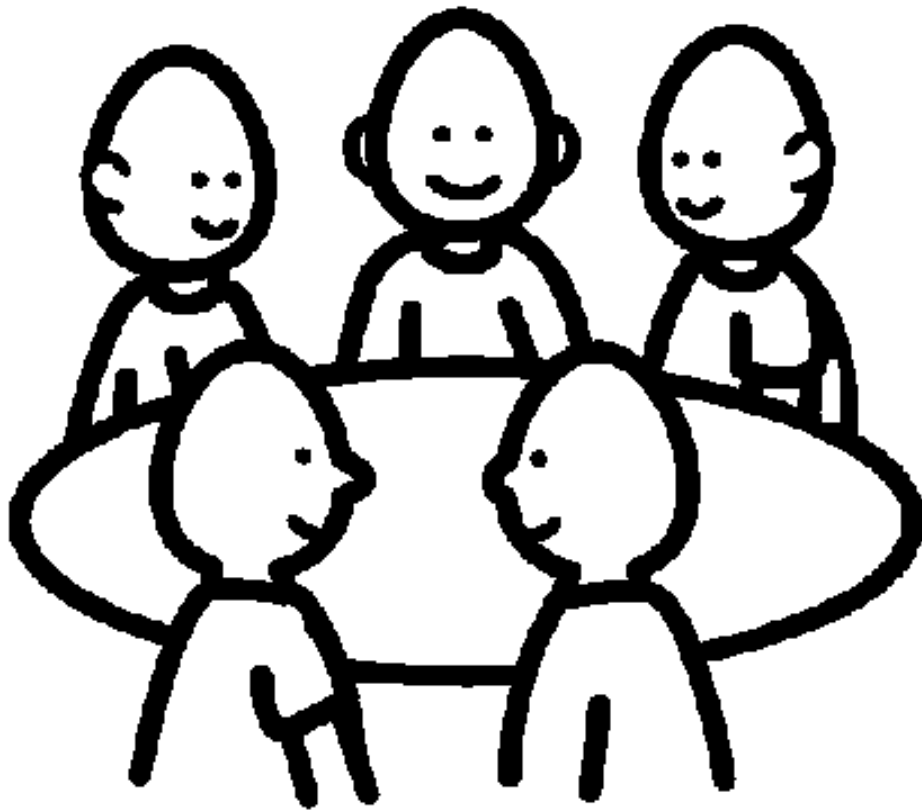
Tim made sure no
one teased Jacob.



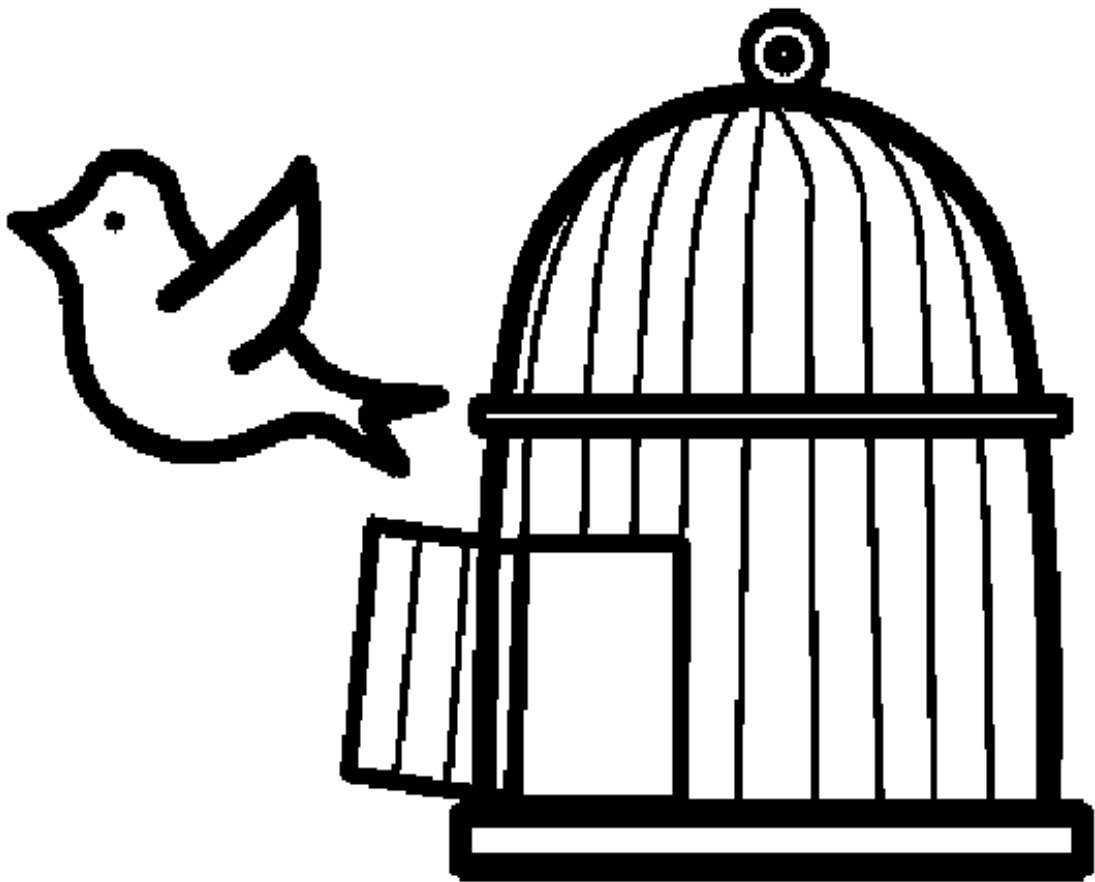
Soon other children

to school.



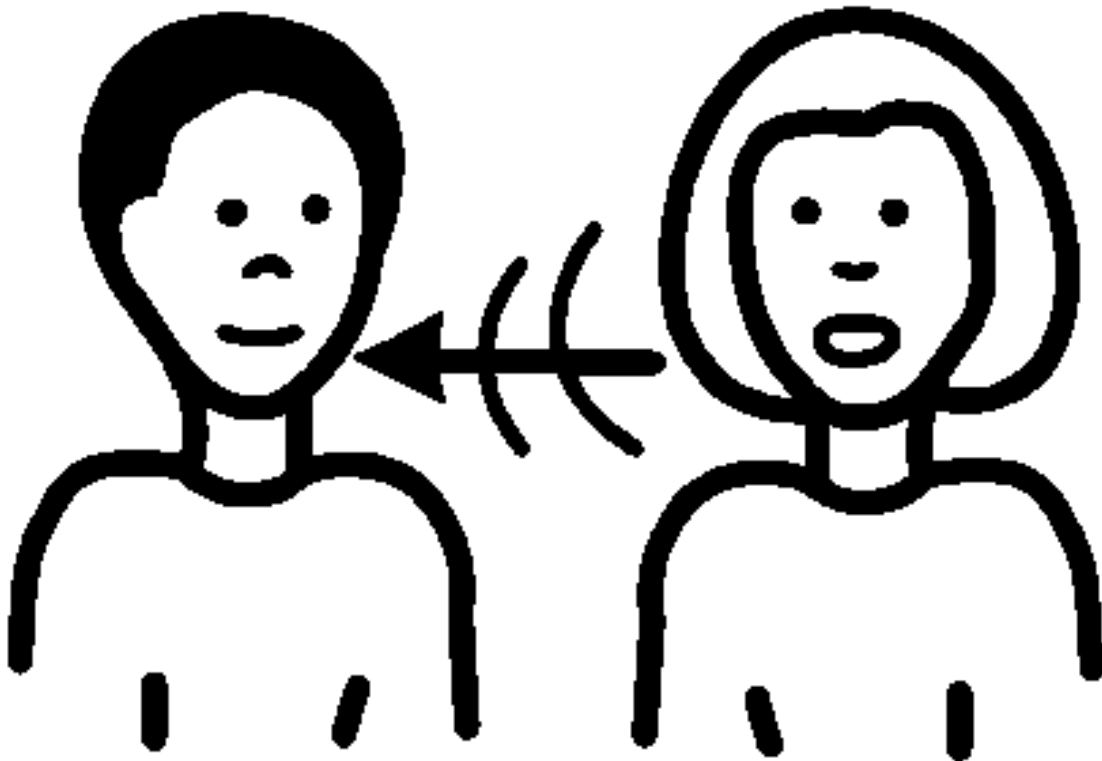
Jacob felt free to
be himself.



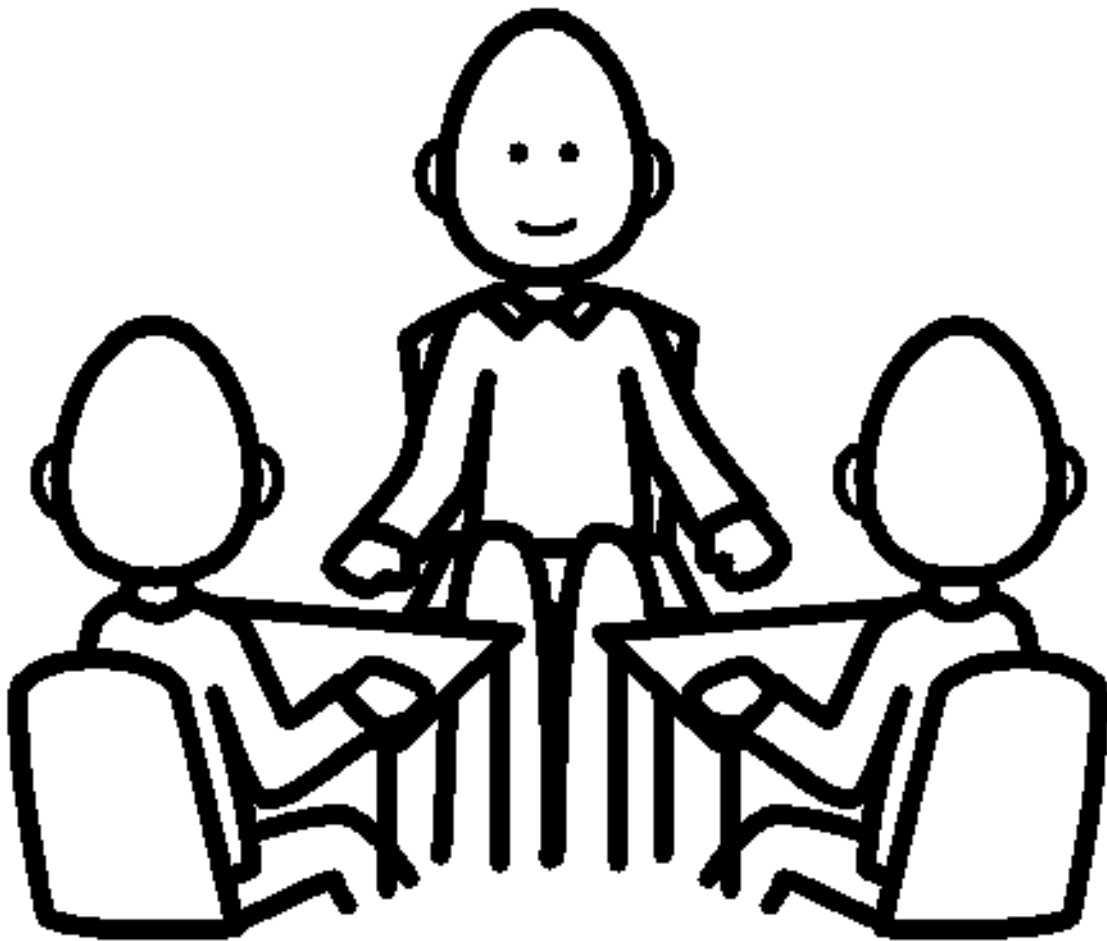
Other classes

wearing pink.



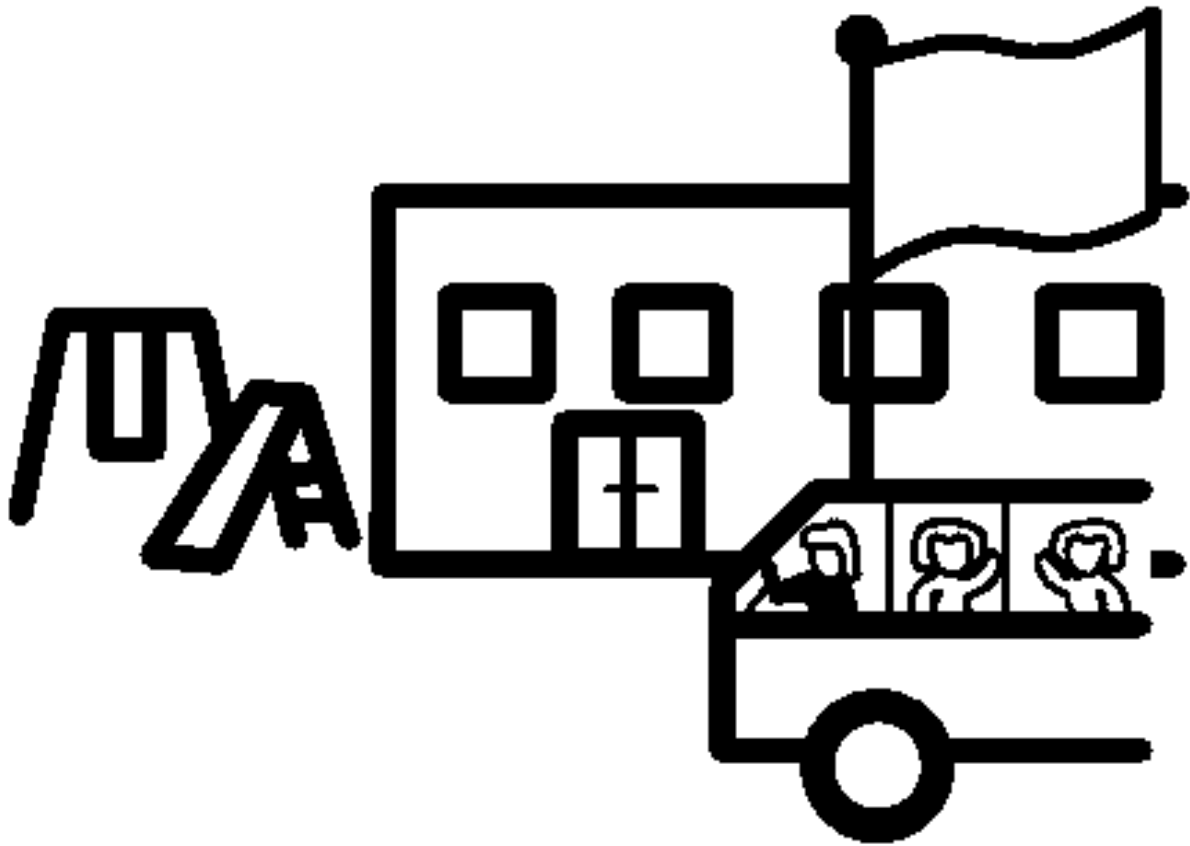
Jacob's teacher

teachers.



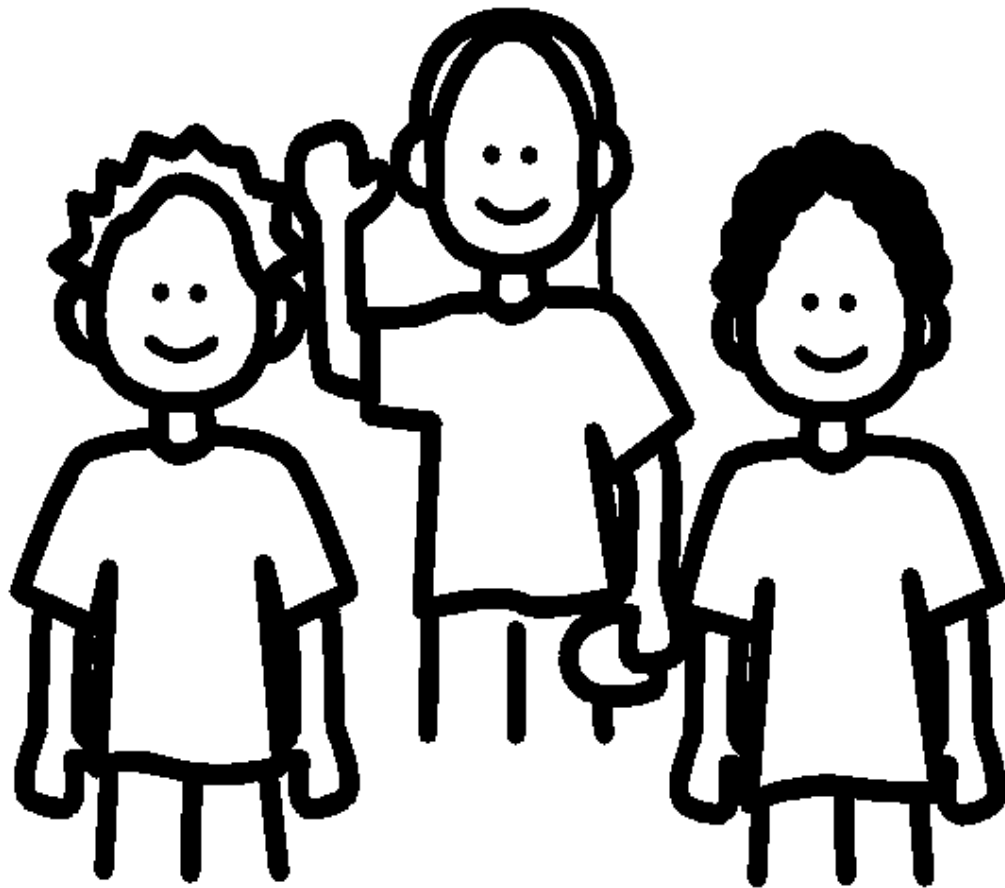
The other teachers

Jacob's story.



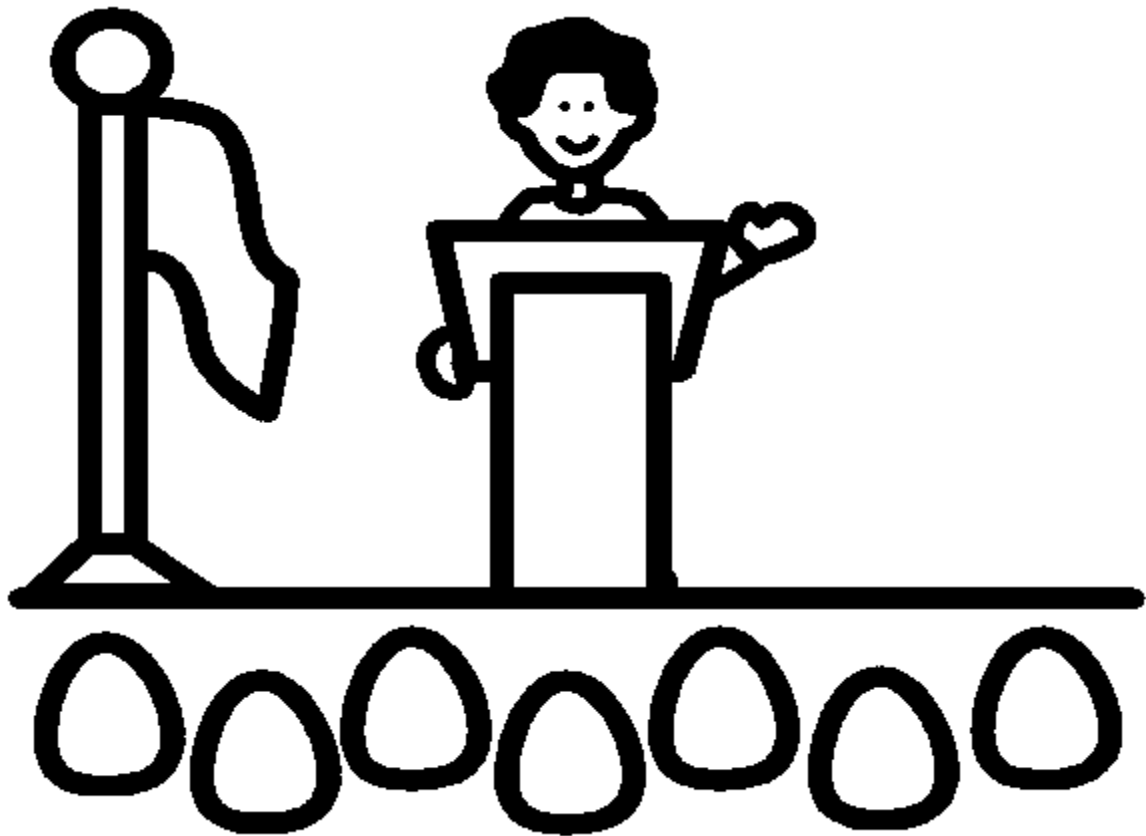
It didn't take long

whole school.



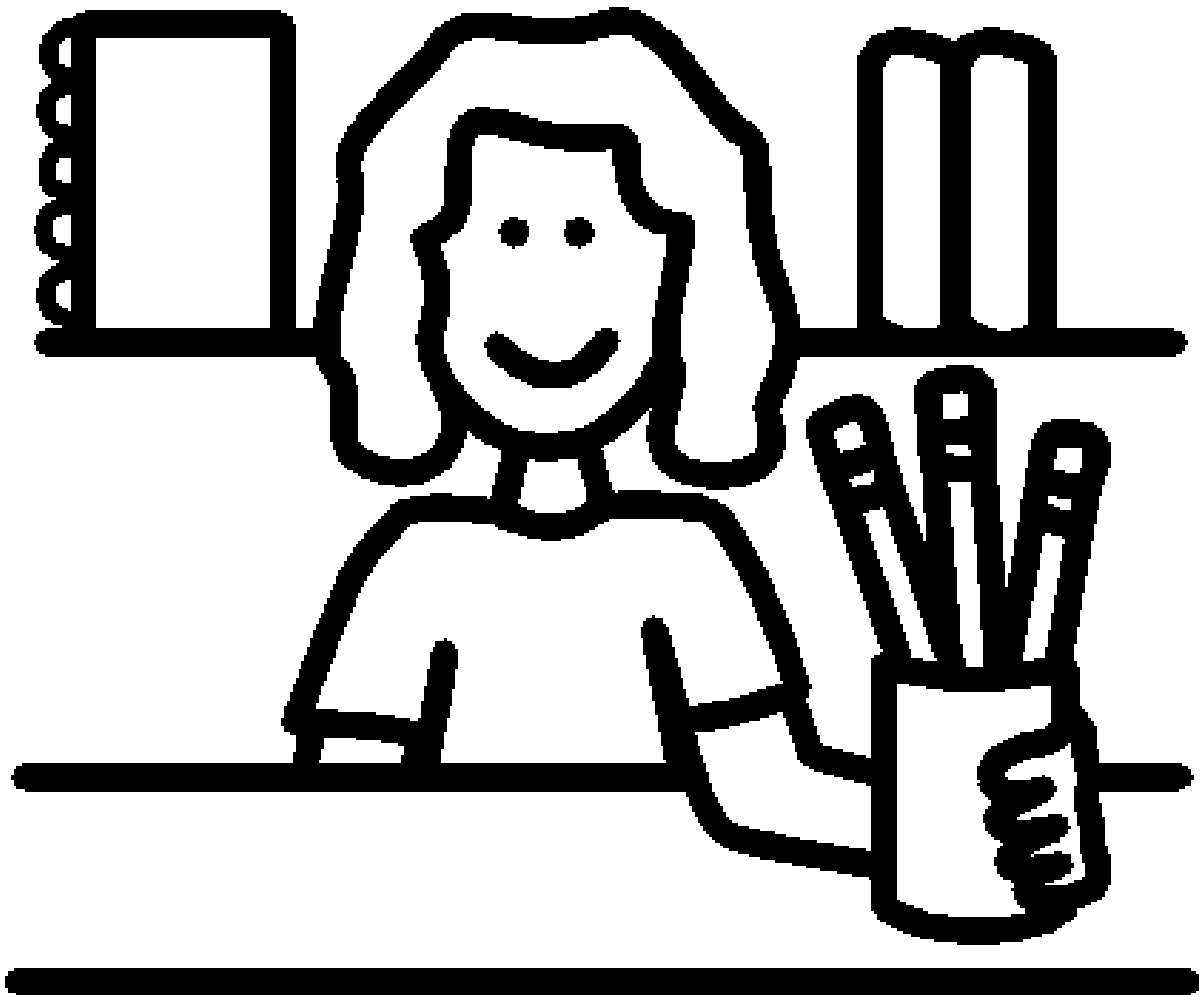
More and more

even the boys.



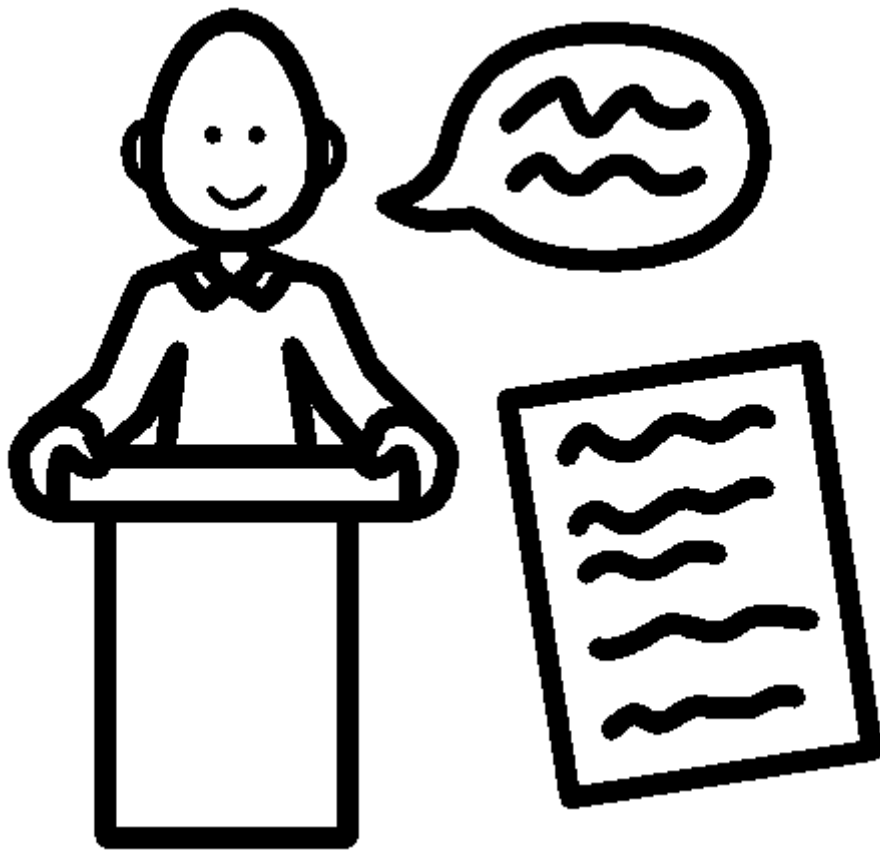
The principal

Day celebration.



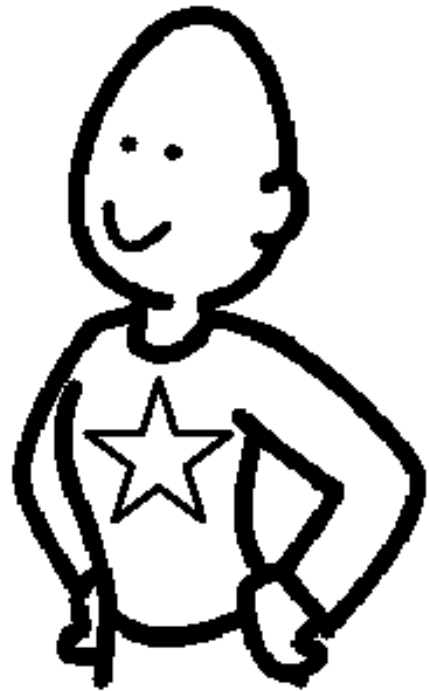
Everyone wore pink shirts to school.



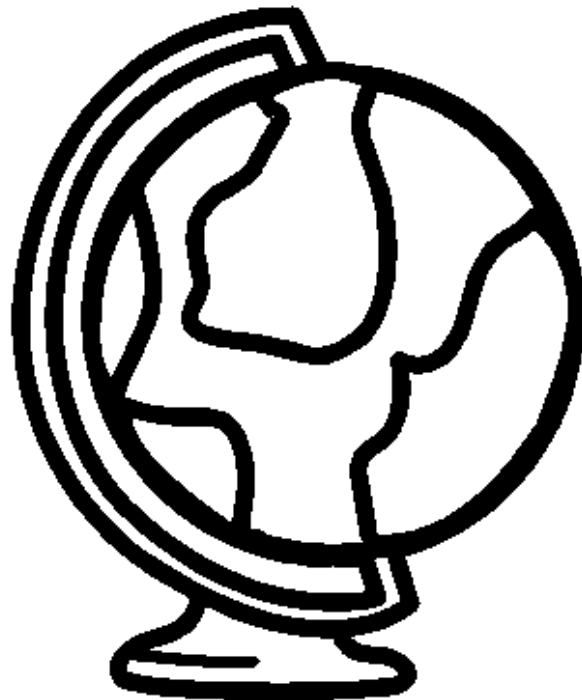
Students made presentations about accepting others for who they are.



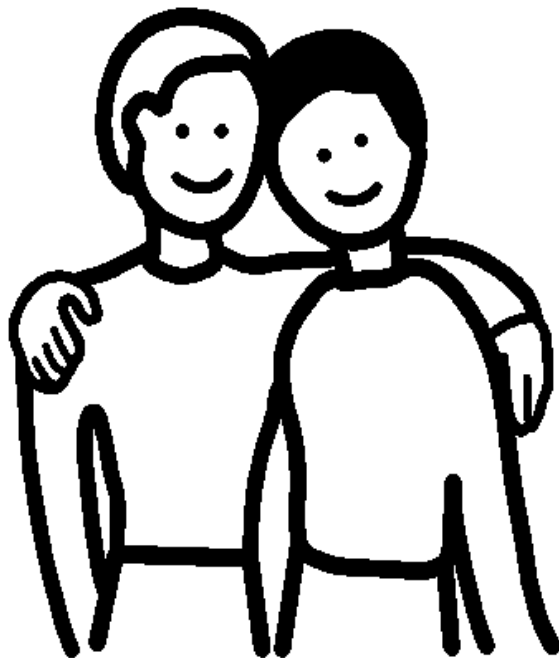
Jacob and Tim

their bravery.



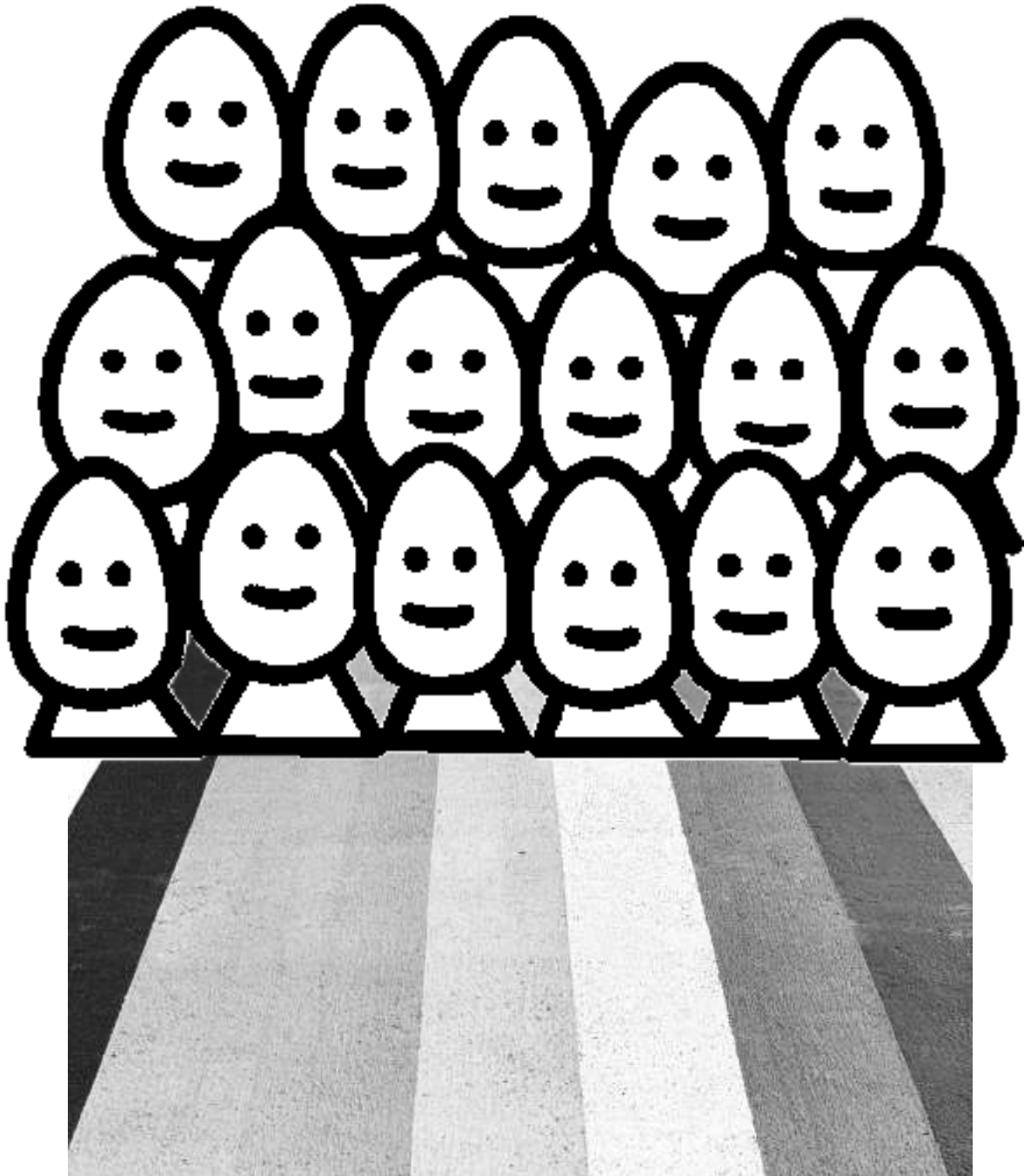
Other schools

and important.

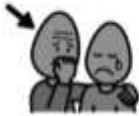

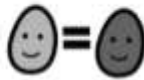

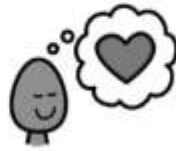
