


# Jacob was a new student in our class.




# Jacob's favourite colour was pink.



# Jacob liked to draw and colour pink things.




### Jacob liked pink marbles.




# One day at school, some older children teased Jacob for wearing a pink shirt.




Other schools heard about Pink Shirt Day and decided to have a Pink Shirt Day too.


